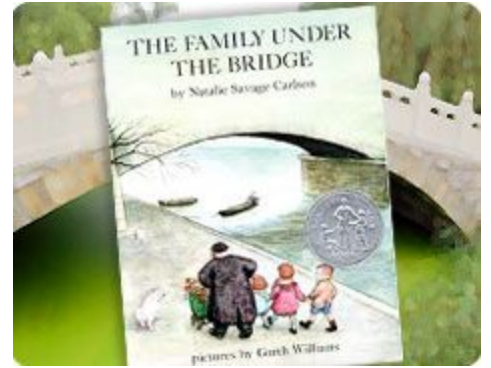


The Family Under the Bridge

Book Project



Summary..... 40 points

A summary tells only the MOST IMPORTANT parts of the story. Do not get carried away with details. You can handwrite or type it (use Arial or Times New Roman, 12 point, black, double space). It should include:

- 1st paragraph: title, author, introduce the main characters and the conflict in the story - what problem do the characters face? How do the main characters meet each other? (4-6 sentences)
- 2nd paragraph: tell the major events in the story in sequence from beginning to end - focus on the most important parts. (5-8 sentences)
- 3rd paragraph: tell how the story ends and explain any changes the characters may have gone through - do they feel or behave the way they did in the beginning of the story? (4-6 sentences)

Diorama.....50 points

You will build a three dimensional diorama representing an important scene from the story. You can choose any scene from the book. You may use a shoe box or other materials. It must include:

- Brief description of the scene written on an index card and glued to the back of the diorama. (2-3 sentences)
- Three dimensional details - this is not only a drawn or painted scene! You can use real objects such as rocks, sticks, models, Legos, fabric, etc.
- Detail and creativity are expected!

Grammar/Neatness.....10 points

Your report and diorama must have correct grammar and spelling, neat handwriting or typing, and be carefully done.
