Scholastic Book Fair

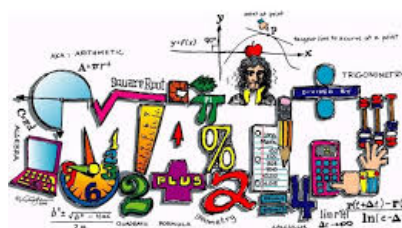
Book fair is 11-14. If you have time to volunteer please ask your child for the letter sent home or email Mrs. Knight.
