STAKEHOLDER INVOLVEMENT

Students, parents, and staff had the opportunity to provide input through:

Survey results indicated our families were divided on their preference for in-person or remote learning with a lean towards remote, so a model was created to best meet the needs of all families.

SURVEY RESULTS

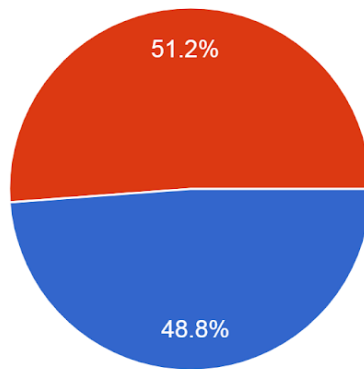
97% OF FAMILIES RESPONDED TO SURVEY 1

Survey 1



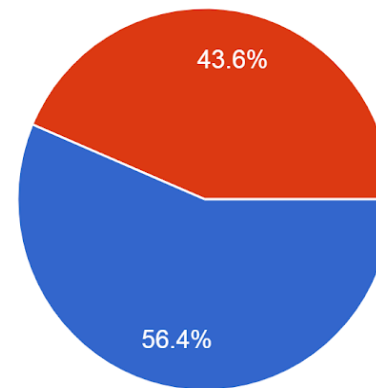
● Remote

LEARNING OPTIONS

In-Person Learning

- Students attend 5 days a week for direct instruction with content teachers
- Edgenuity courses for 7th & 8th grade students remain available at home 24/7
- Helpline remains open for retakes

Virtual Learning

- Students attend Zoom sessions 5 days a week for direct instruction with content teachers
- Edgenuity courses for 7th & 8th grade students remain available at home 24/7
- Helpline remains open for retakes

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

- Students are scheduled for remote or in-person support services
- All IEP and 504 accommodations will be followed
- Speech, OT, and counseling/social work will be scheduled in-person or remote



STAFF AND STUDENT HEALTH

- Social Emotional Learning (SEL) supports are included in Zoom and in-person sessions to connect with students and provide coping strategies.
- Health checks, including temperatures, are completed by staff and students daily.
- Staff or students exhibiting symptoms or with a temperature above 100 should remain at home. If at school, the individual will be isolated until they can return home.



HEALTH AND SAFETY



- Masks will be worn at all times on campus and can only be removed when actively eating or drinking.
- Students who refuse to comply with mask wearing will be removed to remote learning.
- Hand sanitizer will be used upon entry to the facility, when returning from breaks, and is available in multiple areas throughout the classrooms and campus.
- Follow floor and seat markers to maintain social distancing.
- Students have antibacterial wipes available to clean stations before and after use.
- The facility is sanitized daily by UV light.

COVID-19 CASES

- If you or a household member tests positive for Covid-19, please report to our Covid Point of Contact: Lisa Mora, lmora@sslc-nm.com
- Positive staff and student cases will be reported to the NMPED/DOH and NM Environmental Department.
- All close contacts will be notified of their potential exposure and be required to quarantine following NMPED/DOH guidelines.



WHAT IF MY CHILD NEEDS TO QUARANTINE?



- Students who test positive or are identified as a close contact will join remote sessions until the quarantine period is over.
- Testing for Covid is not **REQUIRED** for close contacts, but is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED**. Tests should occur no less than 3 days, but ideally 7 to 10 days after exposure to the positive individual.
- How long is the quarantine?
 - The length is determined by the Department of Health, but is generally 10-14 days following the last exposure to the positive individual.
- Do other family members need to quarantine?
 - No. Only individuals directly exposed to Covid-19 or who are experiencing symptoms need to quarantine.
- Quarantined students should:
 - Remain at home except for essential medical care
 - Limit contact with others in the home
 - Be monitored for symptoms

NM PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SAFETY ASSURANCES

SPLC has met all requirements with the NM PED to return to in-person learning.

- Increased HEPA filtration
- Socially distanced stations and cohort student groups
- Sanitization procedures and equipment
- Covid safety signage
- Personal protective equipment inventory
- Mandatory staff surveillance testing
- Covid Point of Contact to monitor cases, PPE, testing, and contact tracing
- Walk through visit from NM PED to assess compliance
